  - Providing supportive counselling and psychotherapy and crisis intervention.
  - Teaching on health and lifestyle matters in a non-judgmental manner.
  - Referring to specialists, hospitals or other agencies as required.
  - Advocating for patients with other medical workers, agencies or institutions.
  - Supervising other medical personnel within the team.
  - Providing after-hours medical care for WHIWH-CHC clients in rotation with other MDs.
  - Ensuring standards of patient care are maintained according to accepted medical standards and WHIWH-CHC policy.
- Advocating on health and related matters on a larger front for the community as appropriate.
- Recognizes and implements the educational component of Primary Health Care by supervising and evaluating Medical Residents with other members of the Clinical Team.
- Assists with the administrative tasks of WHIWH-CHC and the Primary Care Team by:
  - Participating in data collection and analysis and on-going monitoring and evaluation of WHIWH-CHC programs for various purposes (e.g. program planning, research, etc.).
  - Participating in planning and evaluation of WHIWH-CHC programs and activities.
  - Participating in Peer Review.
